In addition to our Wildlife Care Internship we will be offering a joint summer internship with Mt. Agamenticus at their Learning Lodge. Interns selected for this position will work 30 hours per week with the Center for Wildlife and 10 hours per week with Mount Agamenticus. This internship will provide the same experiences and training in wildlife care, ecology, and education of our Wildlife Care Internship but will also link public education and nature center staffing experience through Mt. A. Duties at the Mount Agamenticus Learning Lodge will include staffing the Learning Lodge, assisting and teaching the public about displays, educating the public about trails, habitats, wildlife, and history of Mt.
